Available Services

Self-Choice Grocery Store

Shopping at our no-cost grocery store provides a five-day supply of groceries to supplement other sources of food. Anyone who needs help is invited to shop once every two weeks. There are no eligibility requirements to shop. We ask customers to fill out a simple information sheet, but all personal information remains confidential.

KidsPantry

Provides in-school and weekend food access to students in grade school. The pantry model offers students the privacy and autonomy to choose items that best suit their needs. Healthy, kid-friendly foods are distributed each week to participating schools and facilitated through each school's counselor's office.

Bonus Room

Located on the exterior southwest corner of our building, the Bonus Room is home to overflow bread, produce, and other food and non-food items. There are no forms to fill out; anyone may use the Bonus Room as frequently as needed.

Kids Summer Lunch

Open to all kids and teens 18 and under during the summer months. Free, healthy meals are available at sites across the Gallatin Valley. There are no applications to fill out or proof of income. Just show up and enjoy a meal.

Healthy KidsPack

Provides weekend supplemental food bags that offer reliable, healthy food access to grade school kids across Gallatin, Madison, and Jefferson counties. KidsPacks are packed and distributed to schools every Friday during the school year.

Senior Groceries

For eligible seniors, this state program provides monthly supplemental foods for adults 60 years and over whose income is at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
